

Book Review Guide



A book review should also offer opinions about the characters, the plot and the way it is written, without spoiling anything!

Paragraph 1: An Introduction

- Explain what the book is and who it is written by
- Give a brief overview of whether you thought it was good, amazing, terrible or horrifying!
- Say who you think should read the book: children, teenagers, adults, boys or girls

Paragraph 2: The Plot

- Tell us what sort of story this is. What is the style or genre (e.g romance, spooky, crime)
- Explain what you think the author was trying to tell people about – what did they want people to feel or think when they finished the book. Again, no spoilers!

Paragraph 3: Characters

- Explain who the main character is: what they are like, what's good about them, what you don't like about them
- Explain who your favourite character is and why

Paragraph 4: Best Bit!

- Explain what your favourite part of the book is, giving reasons why it was your favourite part!

Paragraph 5: Conclusion

- Would you recommend this book to someone else?
- Summary of your opinions about the book
